Alamo Retriever Club HRC Regular Hunt Test May 16 & 17, 2009

Come join us the weekend of May 16th for our Saturday and Sunday out-of-season Duck Hunt!

GROUND RULES:

We thank Tom & Meta Syfan for their generosity in hosting our hunt test on their beautiful ranch. Please be respectful of this property by picking up and disposing trash, including cigarette butts and closing any gate that you open. Please know where your children and dogs are at all times. There are large Pyrenees working dogs on the ranch so please do not let your dogs run loose.

Every person entering the property will be required to sign a liability waiver. This will be done at Headquarters when you check in. Parents or legal guardians will be responsible for minors.

We want you to bring your good spirit and the "other" spirits; however, drinking alcoholic beverages will be limited at the headquarters/tailgate area and only after the "beer dog" runs in the last stake of each day. No training on the grounds. Exercise your dog away from the stake sites. Dogs are to be leashed and crated at all times. No bitches in heat are permitted on the grounds.

FOOD:

Lunch will be offered for purchase both days. Our club will host a complimentary tailgate party on Saturday evening for all handlers, guests, workers and judges at Headquarters during the ribbon ceremony.

RIBBONS

If you're unable to attend the tailgate and awards ceremony (shame on you), but want your ribbon mailed, give the HT Secretary \$5.00, or your own self-addressed, stamped envelope.

DIRECTIONS:

From the San Antonio area, take IH 10 West through Kerrville and Mountain Home. Take the Midway Exit (Exit # 484). Take a left and go under IH 10. Turn RIGHT (west) on the access road for approximately 3.5 miles. You will see a tunnel on your right that goes back under IH 10 (3 Mill Road). Go through the tunnel. Push the red button on the silver box to open the electronic gate. Follow the road to the houses in the center of the ranch.

From El Paso area, take IH 10 East. Take the HWY 290 exit going towards Fredericksburg. Go approximately 1.5 miles. You will see a gate with two very large and tall posts on the right. Go through the gate and follow the road to the houses in the center of the ranch.
