DIRECTIONS:

The tests will be held at Seco Valley Ranch in D'Hanis, Texas. D'Hanis is located between Hondo and Uvalde off Hwy 90. Use the map on the following page to locate the test grounds, which will be marked at the FM 2200 entrance.

From San Antonio area, take Hwy 90 west, thru Hondo, to D'Hanis. Turn left (south) on FM 2200 and drive approximately 6.2 miles. The entrance to Seco Valley Ranch will be on the left set in a tall game-proof fence.
